Dear Friends of Walindwa,

The year 2019 has been a year of true blessings and growth for EBCCK and EKHS.

The campus continues its efforts to increase self-sufficiency. Following a ban by the Kenyan government on unlicensed logging and charcoal production (charcoal being a major cooking fuel), the Kenyan Elma Barnett board responded by constructing a biogas system. The system uses manure from our milk cows to create methane that can be used for cooking and heating. It's a bit embarrassing to admit that we're excited about cow poop – but we are!



The year also brought increased focus on Elma Kamonong High School (EKHS). Our early partnership in this area was on building the school, getting it up and running, and recruiting staff and students. Now that several classes

Physical improvements supporting this goal include the completion of a second teacher's dorm and the beginning of construction of a house for the principal.

What's next? In the coming year

we invite you to pray for continued improvement of the educational experience at EBCCK and Elma Kamonong High School, through teacher recruitment and training and completion of the principal and teacher housing. We are also working to discern the Lord's guidance as we look to the construction of a media center/library with computers and the latest learning tools. The Weller-Sparling Media Center will be a big step forward in the education and training of our elementary and high school students.
